Boeing issues their BPEA annually to recognize suppliers that have achieved superior performance. Orion maintained at least a Silver composite performance rating for each month of the performance period, from October 1, 2012, to September 30, 2013.

This year, out of Boeing's approximate 17,000 suppliers worldwide, 582 suppliers achieved either a Gold or Silver level BPEA. Orion is one of 458 suppliers to be awarded the Silver level of recognition. This award means Orion has been in Boeing's top 3.3 percent for four consecutive years.
